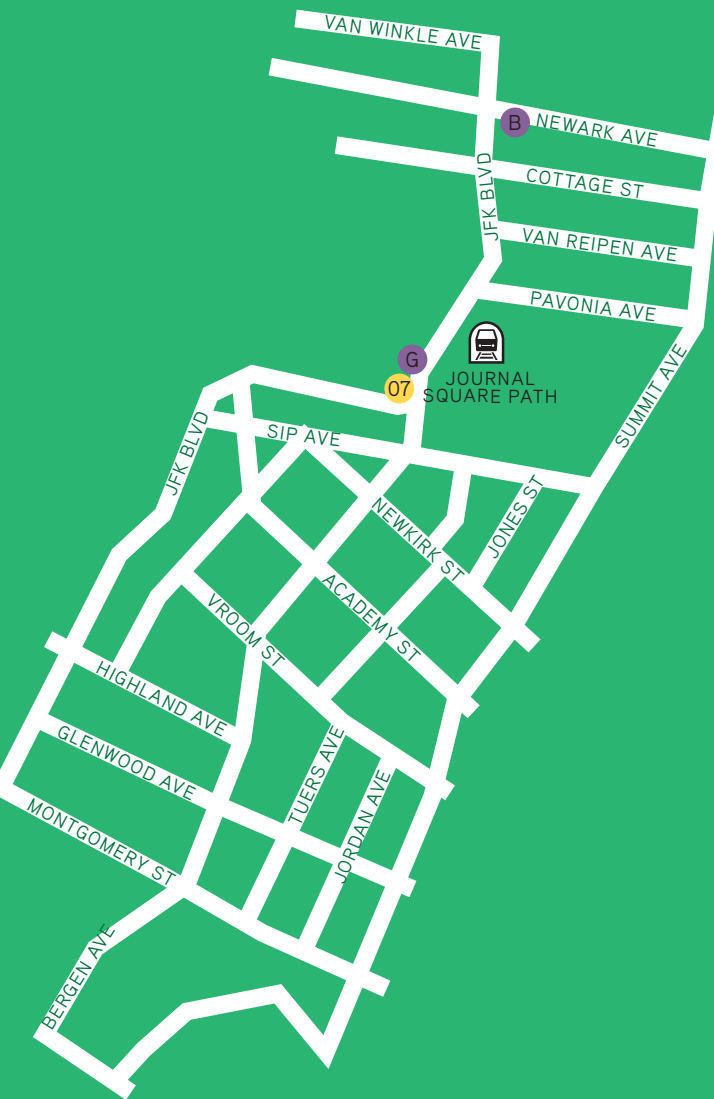

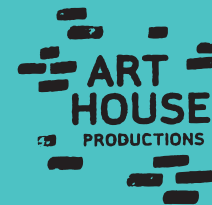

getting around

DRIVING DIRECTIONS FROM THE BARCLAYS 2009 TO GROVE ST/DOWNTOWN JERSEY CITY

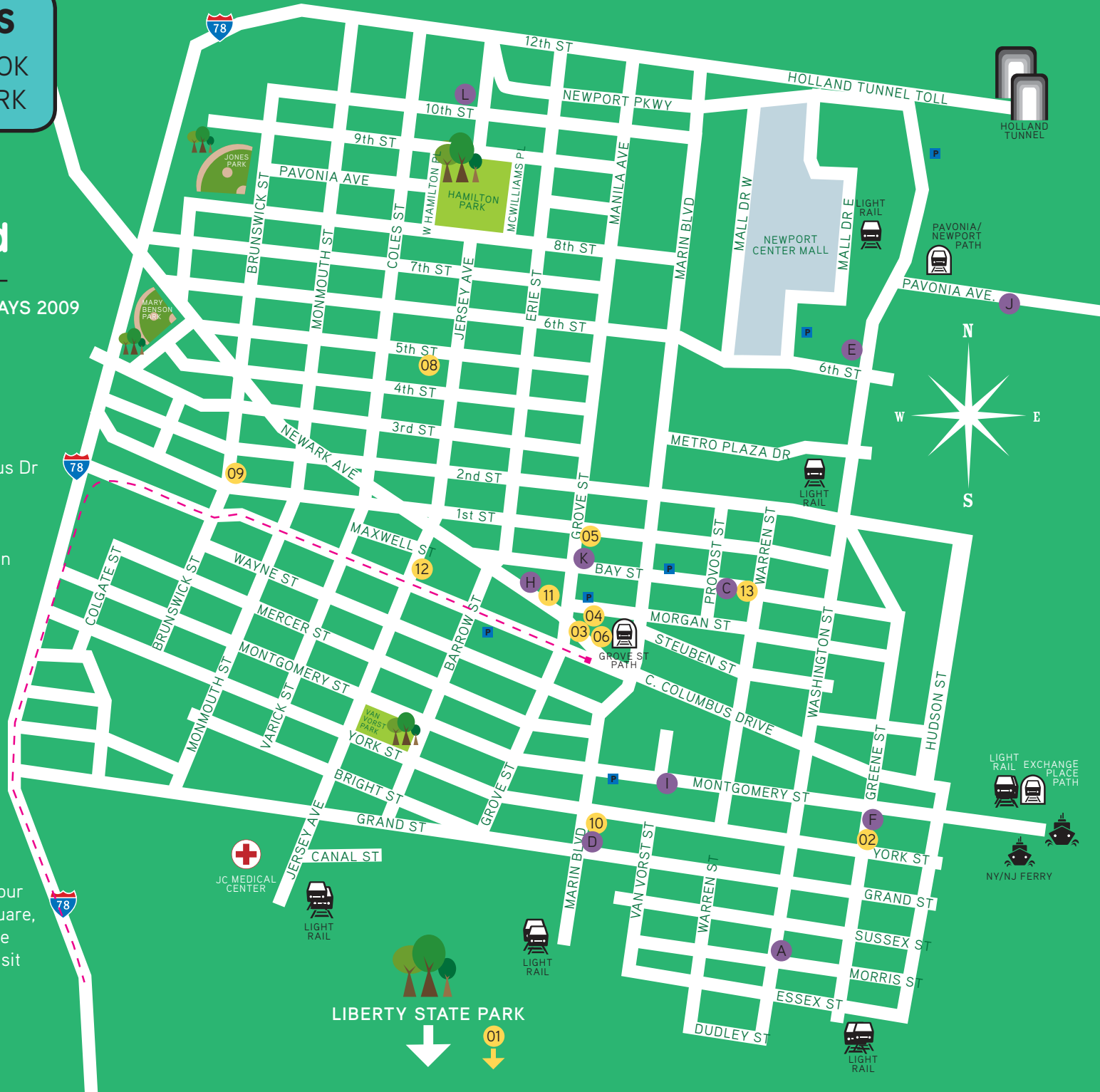
- Head east on Caven Point Rd toward Black Tom Rd
- Turn left at Black Tom Rd
- Slight right to merge onto I-78 E (Partial toll road)
- Take the exit toward Jersey City/Columbus Dr
- Straight through light at bottom of ramp, continue to sharp right bend, this will put you on C. Columbus Dr.
- 5th light is Grove Street. The PATH station and Grove Plaza will be to your left.

A portion of the above route is noted in magenta on the map.

Street Parking is available and there are a number of parking garages around PATH.

MASS TRANSIT

Taking the Light Rail from Liberty State Park and The Barclays 2009 to any SEE WHAT'S HEAR FESTIVAL location is simple and easy. Just take the Light Rail towards Hoboken and get off at any of the downtown or waterfront stops marked on our map.
